

## **NZTFI NO STRIKE POLICY – (Zero Tolerance)**

(as adopted by NZTFI for domestic competitions)

- Any player found guilty of striking another player first will be sent off and will be disqualified for the remainder of the season or a period determined by the Module Coordinator with no right of appeal.
- The Module Coordinator may vary the length of the suspension after considering the severity of the incident and on what round the incident occurred. i.e. if the strike was done during the finals series the suspension may carry over to the next season.
- Any player found guilty of striking another player in retaliation will be automatically sent from the field and will also serve a suspension. The duration of this suspension will be at the Module Coordinators discretion.
- No registration money will be refunded to the guilty player and or transferred to team member if a player is suspended for striking.
- Players are not permitted to participate in any Representative Tournament if they are currently serving a domestic suspension for striking.
